
At 1:30 refreshments will be served at the Knights of Columbus Hall, 372 Marlborough Street, Keene.

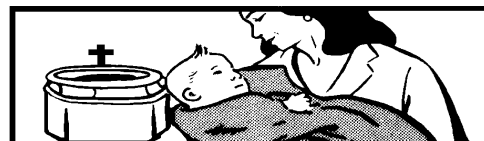
