- Selecting family outcomes

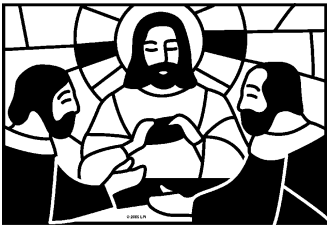
